SCHOLASTICS RAPIDLY APPROACHING--INDEPENDENCE WINS HS INV.

The 12th Annual North Carolina Scholastics will be held April 6-8 at North Garner Middle School with over \$1,000 in trophies (and perhaps \$\$\$) to be awarded. Details of the Scholastics are available in the Upcoming Tournaments section and pre-entries are strongly encouraged.

There were very few surprises in the first Annual North Carolina High School Invitational held at the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics in Durham February 4. Charlotte Independence, composed of John and Kevin Kirby, John Lee, and Jon Pietras, finished first with a score of 9 out of 12. Finishing a close second was the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics, made up of Fred Slocum, Jill Wright, John Lassiter, Toby Falk, and David Petranick, with a score of 8.5. In third place was Enloe (Jun Versola, David Schmidt, Bruce Filgate, Preston Graham, and Bill Stanford) with a score of 6.5; in fourth place with a score of 5.5 was South Caldwell (Joe Helton, Jim Eller, Jeff Walker, and I-Win Huang); and in fifth place was Forest Hills (Tony Cato, Edward Biddix, Hung Crow, Allen Edwards, and Willard Haigler) with a score of 5. A full crosstable is provided in the tournament reports section. This tournament was unique in that middle schools which feed into the high schools were allowed to participate along with the receiving high schools. By the way, I would like to thank John Thomas, Joe Stegall, and David Bahr for their organizational work in this excellent tournament.

As we are going to press around March 15, the results of the Wake County Scholastics were not available for this issue, but they will be published along with the Scholastic results next issue.

I'm looking forward to the Scholastics this year very much--the organization (Esco Yancey and the North Carolina Scholastic Chess Association) has been great, the trophies are beautiful (yes, they are ready!), and the turnout should be excellent (well over 200). Who will join the past list of winners below? We will find out shortly. I hope to see you at North Garner April 6-8.

- M - The active rook and far advanced pawn provide just enough counterplay.
